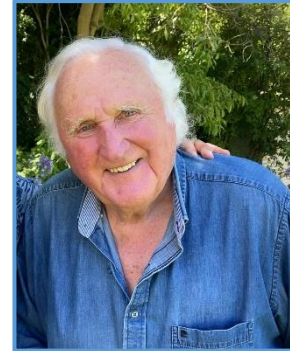

Nomination of Honorary Life Member

Edmund (Teddy) Kuttel



- A Member of the Club since 1952, started his sailing at RCYC in 1942.
- Honorary Treasurer for three years in his early twenties at a time before computers, when he had to write up the books by hand.
- Subsequently, served on the Committee for nine years, the last three of which he served as Commodore, during which time he built the regatta centre, still known amongst older members as "Teddy's tent", which paid for itself in two years.
- Chairman of CASA for two years. Bought the house in Green Point. Put on the Cape to Lisbon Race.
- President of RCYC for fifteen years.
- Has over 100,000 miles of ocean sailing under his belt, including the first Rio Race in 1971, rounding Cape Horn in the 1986 Whitbread and participating in virtually all South African ocean races and winning many of them.
- Still actively sailing competitively, despite his age, and recently won the Round Robben Island Race in style.
- He achieved both Western Cape and Springbok Colours for Ocean racing.
